Guidelines for writing scientific abstracts

Each abstract and presentation:

- Must be written in Microsoft Word or another compatible format, using Arial font, size 11.
- The title must be in bold
- Below the title, the names of the authors and their affiliations must be provided.
- The name of the presenter must be underlined.
- Each abstract must include the presenter's contact information: mailing address, email, phone numbers/cell phone for any communications.
- The page format must be A4, margins 2,5cm on all 4 sides and single line spacing.
- The report should contain a maximum of 300 words and 2,000 characters including, spaces, excluding titles and a brief bibliography.
